Meetings

Unless otherwise noted, meetings are held in the Fellowship Hall of the Traverse City Presbyterian Church at 701 Westminster (off Airport Access Road across from the south entry to Munson's Community Health Center)

Competition, held the first Monday at 7:00 pm

This is a competition and critique of member's photography. The judging is done by the general membership that night. The critique is constructive criticism from everyone in attendance. Entries must be signed in by 6:45.

Digital meetings, held the second Saturday 9:00-11:00 a.m.

These meetings, held in the Church's Youth Room, are designed as how-to instruction and sharing on digital photography. We learn a great deal about different programs that will enrich your photography, from how to organize your files, making panoramas, creating slide shows, how to use the different aspects of Photoshop CS and elements, and other digital related topics. Each meeting includes ½ hour of member discussion.

Program Meetings, held the third Thursday at 7:00 p.m.

These are general meetings on topics that are chosen by the general membership. This could be any photography related topic given by a knowledgeable member or guest speaker.

Workshops and Field Trips

These are hands on learning experiences with your fellow members. They are scheduled sporadically throughout the year. See this year's workshops on the website, field trips are often scheduled with only a few days notice.
